PCL purchased the adjacent 640 square foot building, formerly Sawyers Beauty and Barber, in July 2017.

The building required a new roof, new HVAC, a refurbished façade and a connector to link the two buildings.

The renovation was completed in September of 2018. The total cost for the project including furnishings was \$54,331.




